I was in error. At the June 11 hearing, the P&Z Commission closed the Foothills Plan to public testimony. The continuance to June 25th was only for Commission deliberation and vote.

So, on June 25th, the P&Z Commission will deliberate and act, one way or another, on:

1. The draft Foothills Plan
2. The M3 Comp Plan
3. The Avimor Comp Plan

There will be no public testimony on any of the items. Those of you who did not testify on June 11...hold those thoughts...June 11 may end up being only a dry run for what we need to do before the City Council...

Our response? Show up and watch...watch closely... What this Commission does will set the tone and guide our strategy for commenting/testifying at the subsequent City Council cycle of hearings. I need not repeat anything here about our concerns, issues, analysis or recommendations. See our website (www.nacfa.net -- Updates and Alerts page) to review the NACFA comment letter to the City on the Foothills Plan and its relationship (or lack thereof--wherein the problem lies) with the M3 and Avimor items. There is a lot of other background information there as well.
